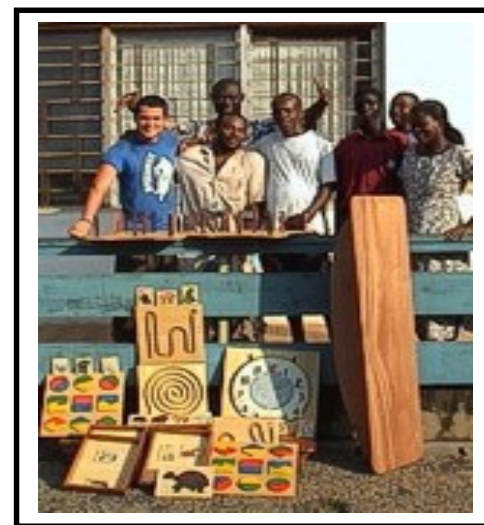

## ✦ Cameroon

- Our partner in Cameroon, West Africa is United Action for Children ["UAC"] based at Buea in the English speaking Province of SW Cameroon. This is in the foothills of Mount Cameroon and close to the coast at Limbe. The main working language is English although French is also widely spoken.
- The UAC mission is to provide support and to enhance a broader socio-economic capacity for underprivileged communities with the focus on youth in Buea. There is a Computer School with 20 PCs donated by us as well as a Woodwork Shop & Nursery.
- There is also a Youth Centre for activities such as Music, Drama, Sports and Art.

## • Ghana

Our partner in Ghana, West Africa is The Bridge Foundation["TBF"] which is based on the coast at Accra, the capital of Ghana. TBF has built and established a Youth Resource Centre for an holistic learning programme for urban youth who were unable to benefit from the normal school programmes. The working language is English.

- The Youth Resource Centre consists of a gymnasium, library, playing ground, IT Training Unit, and two additional Accommodation Units for future international volunteers.
- There is also a rural programme inland at Bawdie in Western Ghana where a library has been built by former volunteers - details on the main ATN Website and on a freely available DVD.

## • Morocco

- Our partner in Morocco, North Africa is Groupe Maroc Horizons ["GMH"] which is based in Taroudannt in the Sous Valley in Southern Morocco. The working languages are French and Arabic.
- GMH offers remedial lessons for those young people in Taroudannt needing assistance with basic English, French and Computer Studies.
- GMH members are professionals resident in Taroudannt who are keen to help develop vocational skills for the young in the town.

Volunteers stay with the host families of GMH Members in Taroudannt. The mid programme visits are to the Sahara Desert and/or Mount Toubkhal.
